**A RESOLUTION to SUPPORT THE CONNECTING COMMUNITIES PROGRAM AUGUSTA TOWNSHIP
RAILSPLITTER DRIVE TRAIL.**

At a regular meeting of the Augusta Township Board of Trustees, Washtenaw County, Michigan, held on July 27, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Gonczy and seconded by Adams.

WHEREAS, Augusta Township Board of Trustee's approved and adopted the Augusta Township Trail Feasibility Study.

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County Parks & Recreation Commission Connecting Communities Program is committed to the continued development of non-motorized trails throughout the County. WCPARC is committing \$600,000 per year through 2024. The intent is to work in partnership with local communities and other organizations, providing funds to supplement those provided or obtained by the partner organization.

WHEREAS, Funding is available for construction projects and engineering.

WHEREAS, Final applications are due by 5:00pm on August 31, 2021.

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Support from the Augusta Township Board of Trustee's of where the trail will be located is required with the Connecting Communities Application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Augusta Township Board of Trustees hereby supports the Railsplitter Drive Trail which is west and north side of Railsplitter Drive from Willis Road to Lincoln Trail, and north and east side of Lincoln Trail from Railsplitter Dr. to Childs Elementary. 7370 feet 1 1/4 miles.
