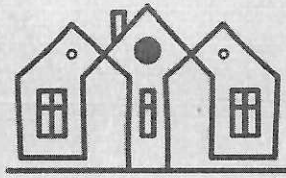


# FEMA Repair Assistance Requires Proof of Ownership



To prove ownership, applicants can provide the following documents:

## PROOF OF OWNERSHIP DOCUMENTS

- Deed or title
- Mortgage documentation
- Homeowners insurance documentation
- Property tax receipt or Property tax bill
- Manufactured home certificate of title
- Home Purchase contracts (excludes Rent to Own contracts)
- Last will and testament (and death certificate) naming applicant heir to the property



Receipts for major repairs or maintenance may be acceptable if no other documentation exists.

### **At a Disaster Recovery Center, you can . . .**

- Register for FEMA assistance by using phone banks at the center
- Check the status of your application
- Meet with a FEMA applicant assistance representative
- Obtain information from state agencies and voluntary organizations
- Discuss U.S. Small Business Administration's (SBA) low-interest disaster loans for businesses, non-profit organizations, homeowners and renters and receive help inputting your application or documents
- Obtain information about additional resources available and how to reduce future damage

All FEMA disaster assistance will be provided without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex (including sexual harassment), religion, national origin, age, disability, limited English proficiency, economic status, or retaliation. **Stay in touch with FEMA:** When you register, you will be given a FEMA registration number. Write down your number and save it. You will need the number whenever you contact FEMA.
