"Headlee" Override Millage Increase Proposal

Shall the authorized general tax millage of Augusta Charter Township which was previously established at 1.16 mills (\$1.16 per \$1000 of taxable value) and now reduced to .8069 mills (\$.8069 per \$1000 of taxable value) by the required Headlee millage rollbacks, be increased by .3531 mills (\$.3531 per \$1000 of taxable value) which increase will restore the original authorized charter millage rate of 1.16 mills and raise an estimated \$332,000 for general fund purposes in the first year of levy.

For example: A \$200,000 home, it would cost \$70.62 a year or \$5.89 a month.

In a growing community, new construction helps offset the annual legally required Headlee Rollback. Here in Augusta Township, there is very little new construction. This will allow Augusta Township to continue serving our community to the best of our ability and to avoid future decline in services.

Proposition for Police Public Safety Millage

Shall the Charter Township of Augusta impose a tax increase in the amount of 1.4 mills for a period of five (5) years, upon taxable property in the Township for the exclusive purpose of providing a dedicated funding source for police protection services to the residents and businesses in the Township. A tax increase in the amount of 1.4 mills will amount to a tax increase of \$1.40 per \$1000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township, and if approved, the new tax will raise nearly \$402,000 for police protection.

For example: A \$200,00 home, it would cost \$280 a year or \$23.33 a month

Augusta Township relies upon the Michigan State Police for police protection. Sometimes, due to their location, the response time may be longer than expected. The proposal for Police Public Safety would allow Augusta Township to have it's own Police Department. The proposal will raise \$402, 000 in the first year if passed. The funds would be used for 3 Full-time Officers, 2 Part-time Officers, 2 Police vehicles. dispatch services, radios, computers, pistols, rifles, uniforms, tasers, ammo, gasoline, vehicle maintenance, and training.

Parks and Pathways Millage Proposal

Shall the Charter Township of Augusta impose a tax increase on all taxable real and tangible personal property in the Township not to exceed .65 mills (\$.65 on each \$1000 of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, 2022 to 2031 inclusive, for the purpose of providing a dedicated funding source to maintain nature preserves, parks, trails, recreational opportunities, including network of non-motorized pathways in the Township? The estimated revenues raised in the first year by the proposed tax increase is approximately \$187,000.

For example: A \$200,000 home, it would cost \$130 a year or \$10.83 a month

Augusta Township completed a Trail Feasibility Study in August 2020, followed in December 2021 with Augusta Township Parks & Recreation Master Plan. There is generous Federal and State funding available for these projects, however they require a Township 20 to 25 percent match.
