August 24 in City of Ypsilanti Registration opens July 15

Registration closes one week before, or when filled.

Specific location is provided upon registration.

Registration is required to attend any County Clean-Up Day.

Events are for Washtenaw County residents only. Materials from businesses, government agencies, non-profits, or other organizations are not accepted.

- Bulky waste

- Checks and cash are accepted at the event. Make checks payable to Washtenaw County.
- Bring 4 tires for free. Suggested donation of \$5 for each additional tire.
 Limit of 10 tires.
- Bring 1 TV or freon appliance for free. Suggested donation of \$10 for each additional item.

Household Hazardous Waste

- Aerosols
- Automotive fluids
- Ballasts (must be removed from fixture)
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Batteries
- Carbon monoxide detectors
- Compressed gases
- Cooking oils

- Home cleaning products
- Home repair products:
 - Adhesives & glues
 - o Caulk
 - Rust remover
- Inhalers
- Medical sharps & needles
 - Must be in medical sharps container

- Mercury & mercurycontaining devices:
 - Thermometers
 - Thermostats
- Nail polish & removers
- Paint & paint thinners
- Pesticides & poisons
- Photography chemicals
- Pool chemicals

Electronics

- DVD players & VCR players
- Cameras & camcorders
- Cell phones, pagers & PDAs
- Computer display monitors
- Fax machines

- Game systems
- Hard drives & optical drives
- Laptops & tablets
- Power & broadband modules
- Printers & scanners

- Stereos & radios
- Telephone systems
- TVs flat screen & CRT

Scrap Metal & Appliances

- Dishwashers
- Dryers

 - Gas & oil must be removed.
- Water heaters

Bulky Waste

- Furniture:
 - Couches
 - Mattresses
 - Shelves
- Flooring:
 - Carpet
 - Wood
- Scrap wood

Tires

- Limit of 10 tires
- Tires on rims are accepted
- Car tires 28 inch diameter or smaller
- No oversized tires (semi or tractor)
- Empty of water and debris
