At a regular meeting of the Augusta Charter Township Board of Trustees, Washtenaw County, Michigan, held in the Lincoln Senior Center, 8970 Whittaker Road, Ypsilanti, Michigan 48197, on the 28th day of January 2025 at 6:30 p.m.

Whereas, the Augusta Charter Township Farmland Preservation Board mileage won the election in 2016 creating a .10 mills annually for ten years.

Whereas, the Augusta Charter Township Farmland Preservation Board has completed one successful easement agreement since its creation, with a second applicant in progress.

Whereas, the Augusta Charter Township Farmland Preservation Board received a third application on January 9, 2025 from a township resident for a Farmland Preservation Purchase of Development Rights for 78 acres.

Whereas, the Augusta Charter Township Farmland Preservation Board fund balance is in a position to contribute additional funds, not to exceed \$100,000 in support of this township resident's application.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the Farmland Preservation Board supports this application and will forward this Resolution to the Augusta Charter Township Board of Trustees for approval.
