**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE
MCIMETRO ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES LLC D/B/A
VERIZON ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES
METRO ACT RIGHT-OF-WAY TELECOMMUNICATION PERMIT**

At a regular meeting of the Augusta Charter Township Board of Trustees, Washtenaw County, Michigan, held in the Lincoln Senior Center at 8970 Whittaker Road, Ypsilanti, Michigan 48197, on the 28th day of October 2025 at 6:30 p.m.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by member Gonczy and supported by member Adams.

WHEREAS, by the attached METRO Act Permit, Right-of-Way Telecommunications Permit, Terms and Conditions from MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services a request has been made for access to and ongoing use of the Public Right-of-Way to construct, install and maintain Telecommunication Facilities and

WHEREAS, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services requests that the term of this Permit shall be for fifteen (15) years from the Effective Date, provided, however, that following such initial term there shall be three subsequent renewal terms of five (5) years. Each renewal term shall be automatic unless Municipality notifies Company in writing, at least twelve (12) months prior to the end of any term then in effect, that due to changed circumstances a need exists to negotiate the subsequent renewal with Company. Municipality shall not unreasonably deny a renewal term; and

WHEREAS, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services does not currently intend to expand the telecommunication facilities in Augusta Township but wishes to comply the METRO Act, MCLA 484.3106(7) Right-of Way Permit per Act No. 48 of the Public Acts of 2002, as amended. The attached 25-22 Resolution MCImetro Access/Verizon Metro Act Right-of-Way Permit FINAL

Terms and Conditions include Exhibit A, current route maps of its existing facilities in the Township's right of ways; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement has been reviewed by the Township Attorney, and all the required information has been provided for the permit, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services includes appropriate documents and has provided the required route maps of its existing facilities in the Township rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to comply with the law, METRO Act MCLA 484.3106(7) as amended, that Resolution 25-22 to approve and authorize MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services METRO Act Right-of Way Telecommunications Permit is warranted in the best interest of public health, safety and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services shall be approved as submitted for fifteen (15) years from the Effective Date, however, that following such initial term there shall be three subsequent renewal terms of five (5) years. The authorized hereby shall be subject to all the terms and conditions set forth in the permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Upon return of a fully executed copy of the permit extension letter from said Company, the Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution together with a fully executed copy of the attached Terms and Conditions and current route maps with the Director of Telecommunications Division, Michigan Public Service Commission, Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.
