Resolution to Adopt Cross-Connection Fees to Utility Customers

RESOLUTION NUMBER 26-07

Resolution 26-07 was adopted at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of Augusta Charter Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, held at the Lincoln Senior Center, 8970 Whittaker Road, Ypsilanti, MI 48197, on February 24, 2026, at 6:30 pm.

WHEREAS, the Township provides public sewer and water services to Township residents in accordance with the Augusta Township Water and Sewer Use Ordinance of 1984, as amended, and in compliance with the Revenue Bond Act of 1933; and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Bond Act of 1933 and the Township Water and Sewer Use Ordinance direct that no free service shall be furnished by the system to any person, firm, or corporation, public or private, or to a public agency or instrumentality; and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Bond Act of 1933 and the Township Water and Sewer Use Ordinance, as amended, by a Township Board resolution must produce sufficient revenues to provide for the payment of expenses of administration, operation, maintenance, and improvements to the system, for the purpose of preserving the public water utility system in good repair and working order; and

WHEREAS, the Township was issued a violation from EGLE for not having a residential cross-connection program in place; and

WHEREAS, the Township Utility Operator recommended HydroCorp to provide services to manage both commercial and residential cross-connection control programs to stay compliant with EGLE; and

WHEREAS, HydroCorp's Cross-Connection Control Program will provide the Township with the necessary data and information to maintain compliance with the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy Drinking Water and Environmental Health Division Cross-Connection Control Regulations; and

WHEREAS, HydroCorp, being the only company that provides all the cross-connection services for state compliance, presented a proposal to the Township that will create an existing plan assessment, public awareness, on-site inspections, enforcement (violation reports, compliance re-inspections) and program management; and

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2026, the Board of Trustees approved the HydroCorp Residential CC Program Agreement not to exceed \$88,287.98 over 5 years; and

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2026, the Board of Trustees approved the HydroCorp Non-Residential CC Program Agreement not to exceed \$5,544.02 over 5 years; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:**

The Township Board finds, approves and determines:

Section 1. The following cross-connection fees for each of the bi-monthly billing cycles beginning March 1, 2026:


